On April 13, 2016, Paula Boyd, of Microsoft, Brendan Kasper, of Vonage, Rachel Petty of RingCentral, Joseph Cohen of Pillsbury, and the undersigned (all on behalf of the Voice on the Net Coalition) met with Matthew DelNero, Chief, Wireline Competition Bureau, Daniel Kahn, Acting Chief, Competition Policy Division, Gigi Sohn, Counselor to Chairman Wheeler, Stephanie Weiner, Senior Legal Advisor to Chairman Wheeler and (separately with) Travis Litman, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Rosenworcel and discussed the importance of maintaining a light regulatory framework for VoIP including with respect to the above-referenced docket. In particular, the VON Coalition expressed interest in the proceeding as it relates to the application of privacy obligations to providers of interconnected VoIP and cautioned against imposing new obligations on VoIP providers.
